K-3 iPad Agreement

Starting in the 2019-2020 school year, all kindergarten through third grade students will be issued a personal iPad and case for their educational use to be kept at school. If reasonable precautions and care are taken in the use of the iPad, the iPad should not experience physical damage. Each student and parent are asked to read this form carefully.

The purpose of this agreement is to outline the course of action should accidental or intentional damage occur to a district issued iPad.

If damage of any kind to the iPad or case is deemed accidental in nature, the district will assume the full repair/replacement costs of the device or case. If damage to the iPad or case is deemed to be **intentional** in nature, the student's parent/guardian will be responsible for the cost associated with repair or replacement. Example repair and replacement costs are outlined below. It is highly unlikely that damage will occur. In the past 4 years we have only had a few instances of iPad damage and they were all accidental.

Example Damage	Cost
Cracked Screen	\$100
Broken Headphone Jack	\$50
Case Replacement	\$35
Completely Destroyed/Lost iPad	\$299

iPads will not be allowed to be taken home by students. In the event that a student does take an iPad home, please make sure it is returned immediately. School iPads will only function when connected to the school's wifi, and can be remotely locked and wiped. If an iPad is taken off school premises and not returned, the parent/guardian will be charged the full replacement cost of the device and case as listed above. A replacement iPad cannot be purchased by the parent/guardian in lieu of repairing or replacing the assigned iPad.

The parent/student understands that damages must be reported right away. Details of the accident must be submitted to the teacher or administration. The parent/student understands they will be responsible for all repair/replacement charges associated with iPad damages caused **intentionally**, or lost due to being taken off school grounds. The parent/student understands that in the event there are repeated "accidents" of a similar nature, the school administration may view this as a situation whereby the student did not exercise proper care and/or reasonable precautions. In the event this should be the case, the student may lose their privilege to an assigned iPad. The student understands and agrees to abide by the rules and regulations of the Morris Area Elementary School and Acceptable Use Guidelines. Failure to abide by these guidelines will result in disciplinary action.
